We know that wherever you are in the world, there is at least someone looking to hang out and show you a great time, such as:

- Musicians having a band rehearsal,
- Experts giving a master class,
- Craftsmen making their wares
- Students and their friends up for something (maybe just a little) crazy,
- Anyone just looking for some company.

We also know (believe us, we've checked!) that wherever you are, there are always travelers or even locals looking to get together right now (or in the very near future), have fun, and soak in the city's atmosphere or head off the beaten path.

At 8locate we help these people find each other.

Right now, we're producing a video about people from around the world, with mini-stories about how no matter where you are, you can find fascinating people, meet them face-to-face, swap stories, learn, and be dazzled together.

Below you'll find instructions on how to record a brief video that our film director will edit to create a mini-film about you and your passions (hobbies, profession, basically anything that makes you stand out, and might be of interest to tourists or just those looking for something to do in your city).

Please shoot 5 to 7 videos, of 10-30 seconds each, from different shots or angles.

Be sure to shoot:

1. You're welcome to say a few words about yourself, where you live (country, city) and what you like to do or what makes you tick (1 shot).
2. Why you feel your activity is interesting (location, approach, the surrounding atmosphere), and tell us a few words about what it is (5-6 shots).

A few more tips:

1. The video must be shot vertically.
2. Check whether the sound recorded
3. The background should be well-lit
4. Try to hold your phone steady
5. Try to avoid any jerky movements in the frame
